## Tips for a great day at preschool

Here are some great tips for making each day the best it can be for your little student.

- Make sure that your child gets enough sleep the night before.
- Have your child arrive with a belly full of breakfast.
- Arrive early so you can take your child to the bathroom and sign in by 9:30.
- Talk to your child about school and what to expect. Reassure them that you will be back to pick them up. Say your goodbyes at the preschool door and leave. Prolonged drop-offs create anxiety and children tend to have a harder time adjusting. The Director and extra volunteers staff will be on-site to help with transition and will call parents if there are any problems.
